







# Alternative method for adding your ORCID iD to your email signature





### 2 steps to add your ORCID iD to a UCT faculty or departmental website

**STEP 1:** Ask the web administrator of your faculty or department's web page to add your ORCID iD next to your name. Here are two examples of what it could look like:

• Your Name <u>https://orcid.org/0000-0002-1825-0097</u>



**STEP 2:** The web administrator will need:

 Your ORCID iD. Find your ORCID iD by signing into your personal <u>ORCID account</u> and copying the ORCID ID URL below your name:

The ORCID icon, which they can download here and needs to be scaled down to the height of your text.

STEP 3: Log into your blog, choose the page where you would like to display your ORCID iD, switch to source code/html editor, paste the html code in the relevant space, switch back to word editor and save.
