About the Funding Opportunity

The Oppenheimer Memorial Trust invites applications for its <u>New Frontiers Award</u>. This recognises the efforts of visionary early-to-mid-career researchers determined to build high-performance research teams and the South African academy. The award is intended to provide researchers with the freedom and flexibility to pursue their research, without bureaucratic constraints, helping them produce significant work and gain international recognition.

Eligibility Criteria

Applications from all disciplines are welcomed

- Hold a PhD or equivalent (e.g. MD if in a medical field).
- Be an early-to-mid-career researcher (i.e. between 5 and 15 years of research experience post-PhD qualification experience in their field).
- Be employed at or have a confirmed offer from proposed host institution.
- Be able to demonstrate a significant body of work and already enjoy considerable national and/or emerging international recognition for high-quality and impactful research outputs.

Award details:

This grant is a five-year award, with a monetary value of ZAR 1.5 million per annum.

- OMT intends to fund 1 award nationally per year.
- Applicants need to be willing and able to dedicate at least 70% of their time to research.

Application Process

- Please note that this is a 2-stage application process. The initial stage requires the PI to submit a concept note, via the <u>funder portal</u>, no later than 30 September 2024. Institutional approval, via UCT's electronic Research Administration (<u>eRA</u>) system, is <u>NOT</u> required at the Concept Note stage. See Concept Note guidelines <u>here</u>.
