

CIPHER Growing the Leaders of Tomorrow Fellowship Programme

The [Collaborative Initiative for Paediatric HIV Education and Research \(CIPHER\) of the International AIDS Society \(IAS\)](#) seeks applications for the [Growing the Leaders of Tomorrow Fellowship Programme](#). The purpose of the fellowship is to contribute to strengthening research expertise in paediatric and adolescent HIV in Asia-Pacific and central, eastern, southern and western Africa.

Award details

Two-year research fellowship of up to US\$70,000 (US\$35,000 per year) to provide a stipend for the fellow and can also support travel for learning visit and/or to attend one international conference.

Eligibility

- Early-career researcher that holds a PhD, MBChB or an equivalent degree in public health, science, statistics, epidemiology or a related field.
- The degree must have been obtained within the last 10 years.
- The applicant must be a citizen of a country in Asia-Pacific or central, eastern, southern or western Africa.

Funder deadline

29 November 2024 (19:00 SAST)
