The National Science and Technology Forum (NSTF) calls for <u>nominations</u> for the 2024/2025 round of NSTF-South32 Awards. These prestigious awards focus on Science, Engineering and Technology (SET) and Innovation in South Africa (SA). South32 is the co-branding sponsor for the past seven years. As such, the name of the awards is the NSTF-South32 Awards.

The call includes nominations in two new award categories, the NSTF-ARC Award for contributions towards sustainable agricultural management, knowledge generation and solutions and the Annual Theme Award for contributions to Quantum Science and Technology in South Africa.

Special Annual Theme Award for 2024: Quantum Science and Technology in South Africa (SA). This theme was chosen in support of the <u>2025 International Year of Quantum</u> <u>Science and Technology</u>. The NSTF is making a special award this year for *an outstanding contribution to SET and innovation in Quantum Science and Technology in SA.*

Nomination is a two-step process:

- Step 1: Register nominations for one of the categories (see list in the next page) by 17 January 2025, 12h00. This can be done via the Research Office or by a nominator completing the NSTF <u>online nomination form</u>. If you wish the Research Office to nominate you, please inform us by no later than Monday, 13 January 2025, 09h00.
- Step 2: Submit a lengthy nomination form, which includes your research achievements and research publications, to the NSTF by Monday, 3 March 2025, 12h00 to be considered for an award. Sample nomination forms are available for <u>download here</u>.

Award categories

Full title of categories: All the awards are 'for an outstanding contribution to science, engineering and technology (SET) and innovation in SA...' (The complete title of each award starts with this wording in place of "contribution".)

1. Individual Awards a) Lifetime Award – outstanding contribution over 15 years or more.

b) TW Kambule-NSTF Researcher Award – contribution through research and its outputs over a period from 6 years up to 15 years of research work from the commencement of the research career, predominantly in SA. c) TW Kambule-NSTF Emerging Researcher Awards –
 contribution through research and its outputs over a period of up to 6 years of research work from the commencement of the research career, predominantly in SA. d) Management Award – contribution through management of SET and innovation and related activities over the last 5 to 10 years in SA.

2. <u>Engineering Research Capacity Development Awards</u> – outstanding contribution by an individual or a team in their chosen SET fields over the last 5 to 10 years

3. <u>NSTF-Water Research Commission (WRC) Award</u> – outstanding contributions in SA by an individual, team, partnership or an organisation towards sustainable water management, knowledge generation and solutions over the last 5 to 10 years.

4. <u>NSTF-SAMRC Clinician-Scientist Award</u> – outstanding contributions through research and its outputs in biomedical areas over a period of up to 6 years of research work from the commencement of the research career, predominantly in SA, and focussed on work to enhance life and to improve the health of the community.

5. <u>NSTF-TIA Green Economy Award</u> – outstanding contribution by an individual, team or an organisation towards achieving biodiversity conservation, environmental sustainability and a greener economy over the last 5 to 10 years.

6. <u>Science Diplomacy for Africa Award</u> – outstanding contribution by an individual or a team in SA, which has led to impactful solutions and/or collaboration in the SET and innovation fields, within the last 10 years, through science diplomacy between and among countries, for the benefit of SA and the African continent.

7. <u>NSTF-ARC Award</u> – outstanding contribution by an individual or team in SA towards sustainable agricultural management, knowledge generation and solutions over the last 5-10 years.

8. Data for Research Award – contribution by an individual or a team for advancing the availability, management and re-use of research data

9. Innovation Awards – for innovations and their research a) Corporate Organisation – contribution by an individual or a team.
 b) SMME – contribution by an individual or a team in an SMME.
 and/or development

10. <u>**Communication Award**</u> – outstanding contribution for outreach and creating awareness of SET and innovation by a team or individual over the last 5 years.

11. Non-Governmental Organisation (NGO) Award – contribution by an NGO including technology transfer, and education and training activities in SA over the last 5 to 10 years.

12. <u>Special Annual Theme Award</u> – Quantum Science and Technology in South Africa (SA); (awarded according to criteria in any of the other categories) For 2024/2025 the award is made for an outstanding contribution to SET and innovation in Quantum Science and Technology.
