Applications are invited for NRF funded postdoctoral position in The Experimental Tuberculosis and Immunology Research Group. The project will investigate the role of microglia in CNS-TB infection using both in-culture and mouse models.

Requirements include:

- A PhD in Immunology, Microbiology, Virology, Neuroscience, Infectious Disease or a related field
- Experience working with models of infectious disease in a research laboratory will be an advantage.
- Experience working in a Biosafety level 3 laboratory will be an advantage
- Evidence of publications/research output in the field of Molecular Biology/Immunology/Infectious Diseases or a related field will be an advantage
- Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively.
- Ability to collaborate effectively and work well in a team
- · Ability to work autonomously, under pressure, and to meet deadlines
- Good organizational skills

Responsibilities include:

- Conduct innovative research in the field of host immune function in the context of tuberculosis
- (Co)-supervise postgraduate students.
- Contribute to project administration and management duties
- Publish research findings in peer-reviewed journals.
- Present work at research forums

Applicants may not previously have held full-time permanent professional or academic posts.
